Plant new hedgerows and install fencing along Stony Brook, with wide margins away from the brook, plus hedgerow and fence along roadside (total hedgerow 255m, total fencing 444m). Two new gates to enable access to wet woodland and brook, and to scrape/wetland area. Reprofile derelict pond to create wetland scrape area .	04/03/2024	31/03/2025	£16,878.28
